<u>Rev. 20:4-6</u> = (teaches) That there are only <u>**2** Resurrections</u> (It's Heaven or Hell)!!!

- 1. <u>First Resurrection</u> = The Rapture (which included martyrs from Great Trib.)!
- 2. <u>Second Resurrection</u> = Raised to be Judged (and sent to Hell) after Millennium.

<u>NOTE</u>: If there is only <u>**ONE resurrection**</u>, which leads to Heaven, and it <u>**includes**</u> those who <u>**did NOT**</u> take the mark of the beast, then this event MUST be <u>**the Rapture**</u> of the Church, and it MUST take place <u>**AFTER**</u> this period (known as) the Great Tribulation!

II Thes. 2:1,2 = Rapture & 2nd Coming - Happen on Same Day; the "DAY of Christ"

 PAUL Taught II Thes. 2:3 = Rapture will _____ come, until "man of sin" (Antichrist) is Revealed!

 II Thes. 2:4 = Antichrist is Revealed (at Beginning of Great Trib.) 3 ½ yrs. AFTER the Confirmation of Covenant) when he stands in the Jewish Temple, claiming to be God.

 II Thes. 2:7 = The Church is the ______ (a SHE). "<u>He</u>" cannot be referring to Church!

 II Thes. 2:6 = Ye KNOW what withholdeth (the revealing of the Antichrist) = TIMING!

Rev. 16:13-16 = During the story of the **Battle of Armageddon**, it's interesting, that Jesus says "**Behold, I come as a** ______." This term was only used by Jesus to describe <u>the Rapture</u> (or gathering of His elect). This proves the Rapture will occur at the battle of Armageddon.

<u>Notes to Remember</u>: At <u>Rev. 19:7-19</u> = The <u>Marriage Supper</u> is just beginning, at Armageddon (AFTER the Great Trib.); <u>NOT</u> at <u>Rev. 4:1</u>

The Great Tribulation = is <u>NOT</u> the Wrath of God (it's the Wrath of Satan). Rev. 12:6-12 (Great Trib) <u>God's Wrath</u> = is poured out at the <u>Battle of Armageddon</u>, after Great Trib.(Rev. 16:13-21 Ezek. 38:18-22) <u>Most of the Events</u> = in Revelation are <u>NOT global</u> events (rather local events); given to reveal the timing of all things prophesied. <u>Rev. 4:1</u> = Can <u>NOT</u> be the Rapture (as this is the <u>FIRST</u> mention of any trumpets). Rapture happens at the "<u>Last Trump</u>" (I Cor. 15:52) <u>Rev. Chapters 4 & 5</u> = are NOT positioned at it's location, to prove a pre-trib rapture, and the saints being in heaven. Rather, they are a <u>Parenthetical Story</u> (Unveiling the Oneness of God); in that, <u>Not even God</u> was worthy to open the seals (in Rev. 5:3) <u>BEFORE</u> He became a man (incarnate). But AFTER His incarnation (in Rev. 5:6-9 = Lamb in THE MIDST of thrown), He became worthy BECAUSE he became flesh!



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
